### **Monthly Meeting**

**Minutes**

**April 15, 2009**

In Attendance: Almost everyone left after Lake-A-Syst presentation!

1. Welcome – Phyllis Stephens, Master Gardener. Lake-A-Syst Chapter #2/Lawn & Garden Management. For those of you who didn't attend, you missed a really terrific presentation! She focused primarily on controlling pests and weeds. She gave great, usable information and was a very entertaining, interesting speaker.
2. Minutes from March 2009 – (Approved)
3. Treasurer's Report – Checking balance of \$2,457.71 with income and expenses from the Fun run and a \$75 check to L\*A\*S speaker. Savings balance is \$2,575.13 with a whopping \$1.67 in interest.

  - a. Add a 2<sup>nd</sup> route and have both 10K and 20K

  - c. Was there a guide at the turn-up to Newman? It needs to be manned so it is not missed.
  - d. Improve Finish Line making the actual finish line clearer, extend the chalk/paint past the line
  - e. Open the other bathroom. (Do we need additional Port-a-potties?)
5. **Rinse Station Landscaping Project** – Needs a sprinkler system installed. There is money in the maintenance fund to cover the expense. Just move forward. Anyone wishing to help should contact Cathy Weston, 773-9420.
